

Paper and Abstract Guidelines

1. The paper should be A4 format (21 x 29.7 cm) and typed and saved in MS Word2003 or Rich Text Format (rtf). Left, right, top and bottom margins should be 2.00 cm each.
2. Title should be in 14-point font, all in capital letters, and centered.
3. A blank line should be left after the title. Names of authors, affiliations and e-mails should be provided after the title.
4. Font size throughout the paper should be 12-point Times New Roman, with single line spacing, and justified.
5. The entire text should be in "Times New Roman".
6. No page numbering
7. One blank line should be allowed between the components of the paper (i.e. introduction, methods and procedures, results, conclusions, references).
8. Figures and tables should fit within page margins, and be in pure black-and-white format. The font size of the titles of tables and figures should be "Time New Roman", 10 pt and centered.
9. Text inside tables and figures should be "Time New Roman", 11 pt.
10. References should be at the end of the paper, listed alphabetically. References and citations within the text should be prepared in the APA format. Footnotes are not allowed.
11. Abbreviations should comply with the standard use. They should be explicated in full at first usage.
12. The paper should be 10 pages long including figures and tables. The abstract should be maximum 150 words.
